The insect pavilion was created in 2010/2011 as part of the overarching “Bayern Arche” project, which is about protecting native animals and plants.

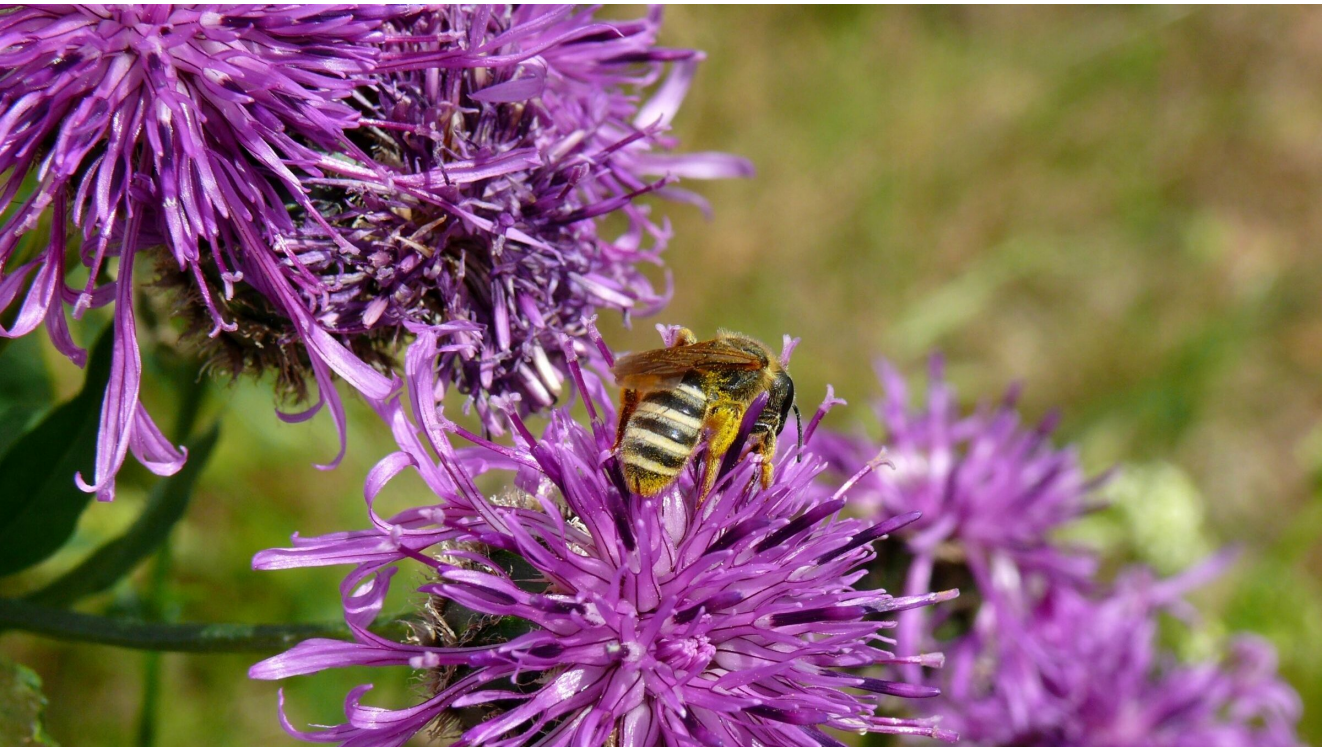
